We had been fortunate to be given a new candle stand by a member of our parish in memory of her father. We are creating a 'Prayer Corner' around this for everyone to use.

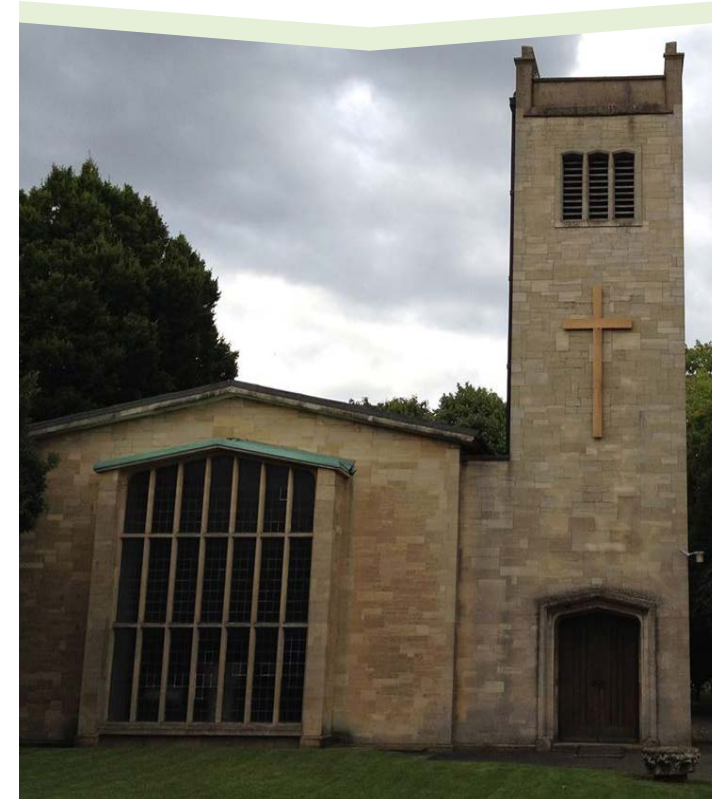

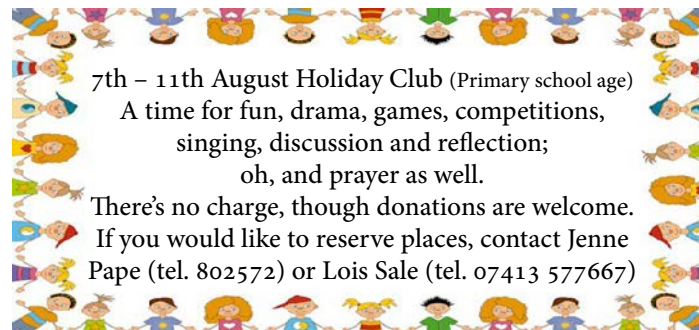
